# **Bus Tour of Historic Ringwood East**

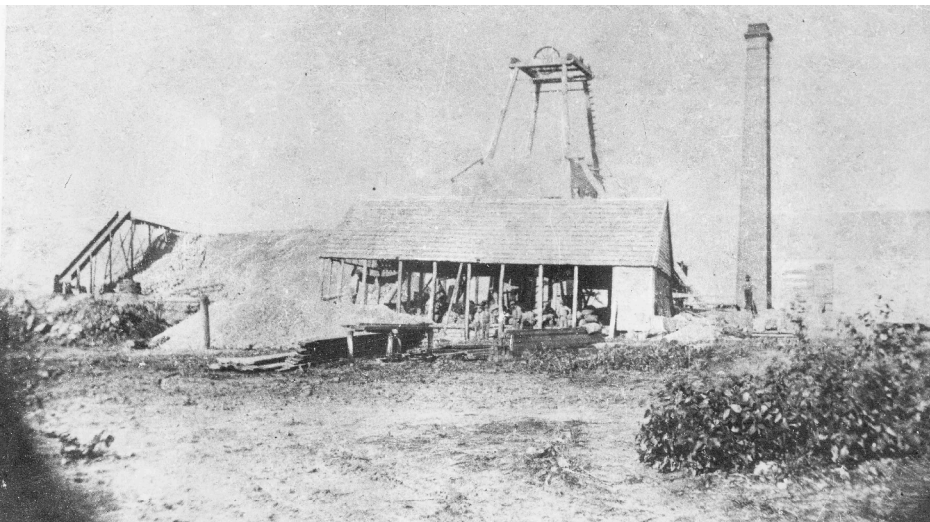
On **Saturday 8th November at 2pm**, the Ringwood & District Historical Society will conduct a guided bus tour of historic Ringwood East.

Ringwood East can be probably regarded as the oldest township in the Maroondah area. Whilst early land-holders and farmers were sparsely spread in the district, from the late 1860s onwards, Ringwood East had a large mining industry, employing hundreds of workers in its hey-day.

The cost is \$15 and must be pre-booked as there are only 40 seats available. Starts at the Braeside Avenue Civic Centre. All tickets must be paid beforehand. Contact Russ Haines on 9876-4367 for details.
